


TRAVEL TIME

Pretoria to Afriski Mountain Resort in Lesotho Via N3 and Hospitaal St: 5h 18 min, 462 km Via R57: 5h 30 min, 473 km

Johannesburg to Afriski Mountain Resort in Lesotho Via N3 and Hospitaal St: 4h 47 min, 406 km

Via R57: 4h 57 min, 411 km Via R76: 5 h 34 min, 479 km



MEDICAL AND INSURANCE

Inform your medical aid and insurance that you're travelling out of the country, in order to make sure you're covered in case of emergency.



RESORT CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT

Check-in time: 16:00pm Check-out time: 10:00am R200 cash refundable key deposit needed on arrival.



TRAVELLING WITH KIDS

Unabridged birth certificates and affidavits are needed to travel to Lesotho.



SELF-CATERING ACCOMMODATION

No grocery stores nearby. Bring own food and beverages for self-catering accommodation.

You are not allowed to take alcohol into Lesotho.



RESORT FACILITIES

Sky Restaurant:

Open for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Expect burgers, pizzas, steaks and homestyle meals. Separate Kids meals available.

Gondola Café: Bar and light meals.

Cooler Box:

On-the-go food and snacks kiosk.



Parents need unabridged birth certificates and required affidavits to cross border with kids.

Border post at Calendonspoort: Opening hours: 06h00 to 22h00 | Monday-Friday

Valid vehicle license disc.

Please bring vehicle registration, insurance, purchase agreements (if on finance) with.

Take cash for toll fees at the border post.

Valid passport.



ON THE ROAD

Ensure you have the correct safety equipment: 2 red triangles, 1 fire extinguisher.

Speed limits in Lesotho: 50 km/h in urban areas | 80km/h on other roads

It is best to avoid driving in Lesotho after dark.

Car needed (depending on season).

4x4 not needed.

Cars above 1.4l engine will make it up the pass.

Check your fuel gauge when you get to Butha Buthe.

Fill up in Bethlehem or Fouriesburg. There's no fuel available near the resort.

Banks open at 09h00 and close at 13h00 weekdays and at 11h00 on Saturdays.

DO I NEED TO TAKE CASH?

Cash for toll fees at border.
R200 cash for refundable key deposit on arrival.
